Eligibility

- 1) The event is open to the Men's Club Champions of every club affiliated to Auckland Golf Inc.
- 2) There shall be played annually a match to be called "The Men's Champion of Champions Match" in which there are 3 Divisions open to Champion of every Club affiliated to AGI shall be entitled to compete.

Senior, Intermediate Junior

Substitutes are not permitted

3) Players may represent their Home Club only.

Entry Requirements & Dates

4) The right is reserved to alter the programme, draw, starting times or date of the fixture if necessary and to refuse the entry of any person without giving the reason for such refusal

Format

- 5) Date: 3rd December 2023
- 6) Tees: Seniors Blue Intermediate - Blue Junior - White
- 7) Format

The match shall be 36 holes of stroke play for the Senior's and a 36-hole Stableford competition with handicap for the Intermediate and Junior Grades. Draw to be made by AGI in threes.

- i. The venue of the Match shall be determined by AGI (refer AGI 5+ Yearly plan).
- ii. The Senior grade carries with it a Cup known as "The Champions Cup" together with a miniature which will be supplied and paid for by AGI and presented to

- the winner after the Match. The Cup shall be held by the winner's Club for one year. The miniature shall belong to the winners.
- iii. In the event of a tie the winner shall be found by a sudden death playoff on the day, if time permits otherwise the championship shall be shared.
- iv. In conjunction there will be a team's event for the Ron Lay Rosebowl, with the Intermediate and Junior Club Champions combining with the Senior Champion to comprise the team. In the event that the Champion is unavailable in any grade, substitution by runner up or semi-finalist is permitted. The substitute is eligible for the team's event only.
- v. Scoring for the Ron Lay Rosebowl team's event shall be Stableford with handicap.
